Bill Talley Memorial Scholarship Fund

Bill Talley graduated from Hedley High School and continued to live in Hedley while educating his two sons in the Hedley school district. He assisted his sons in showing cattle in the Hedley FFA (*need to check and see if they were FFA or 4-H; Lon Adams should know*) and hauled show animals for exhibitors of Donley County. Although his sons were showing cattle and could have easily fed another, he gave his niece a Polled Hereford steer. That steer went on to place sixth at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo in March of 1993.

Bill passed away in 2010 after a brief but courageous battle with cancer. This memorial scholarship was established by his family to honor his memory and contributions to the Donley County Livestock Show's exhibitors. It will provide one student/exhibitor with a \$1000 scholarship, which will be administered through the Donley County Junior Livestock Association.

This scholarship shall recognize students/exhibitors that are hardworking, dedicated to exhibiting livestock and interested in pursuing further education. ACT and SAT scores will not be considered as primary factors when selecting the scholarship winner. Instead, the student's exhibition involvement/achievement and personal characteristics will be the two major deciding factors.

To apply for the scholarship, the student/exhibitor must complete the application and submit it for review no later than April 15, 2011, to the Donley County Junior Livestock Association, either by mail to PO Box 661, Clarendon, TX 79226 or by hand delivery to a board member, the Donley County Agriculture Extension Agent, Clarendon Agriculture Instruction or Hedley Agriculture Instructor.

The application must be typed and be accompanied by an official high school transcript. For your convenience, the application in PDF and Word format will be sent to you via email if requested from the Donley County Agriculture Extension Agent, Clarendon Agriculture Instruction or Hedley Agriculture Instructor.

Applicants may undergo interviews should the selection committee deem them necessary.
