

Inclement Weather/School Delays or Closings

As we move closer to the winter weather season, and the latest forecast from National Oceanic & Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) is for a wetter winter than we have had recently, we want to remind everyone of a few things concerning school delays and closings.

The decision to call for a delay or closing is made with the safety of all our students and staff in mind. Those decisions ideally will be made the night before so that it can be communicated to all and broadcast on local TV stations at the 10:00 news. However, there are times when decisions cannot be made until the morning of; when that occurs, it will be made so that it can be communicated by 6:00 AM.

You will know that delays and closings are authentic when they come from the following sources:

1. A robo call from CCISD (the call will come from an 855 area code)
2. Posting on CCISD's website: <http://www.clarendonisd.net/> which will also have a link to the High School Facebook page.
3. Information on the following TV stations:
KAMR, CH 4 FOX 14 KVII, CH 7 KFDA, CH 10
4. If possible, on the radio stations KLSR 105.2 and KEFH 99.3
5. Clarendon Enterprise: <http://www.clarendonlive.com/> or <https://www.facebook.com/TheEnterprise/>

If school is delayed one hour, school buses will run an hour later than normal; if the delay is 2 hours, buses will run 2 hours later than normal.

The CCISD business office will open 30 minutes before students arrive.

In extreme cases of severe weather, school could be cancelled completely and made up at a later date if we need the minutes to meet the minimum required by law. The scheduled bad weather make-up days are May 10 & 17 for 2019.

Also, please be advised that in case of inclement weather during the school day, students may be dismissed and buses run before the regular end of the school day. Once again, a robo call will be sent out and postings on the school's website and the Clarendon Enterprise sites will have the information.
