1-1 PROTECTION AGREEMENT

Clarendon CISD recognizes that with the implementation of the 1-1 initiative, there is a need to protect the investment by both the District and the Student/Parent. The following outlines the areas of protection.

Computer Use Fee: An annual computer use fee in the amount of \$20 is required to be paid by the parent/student to the district for each computer loaned to a student. This payment is nonrefundable. The annual coverage begins upon receipt of payment and ends at the end of each school year.

Damage Amounts/per incident: The amount of the damage that students/parents will be responsible for is as follows:

1st incident - Cost of repair or cost of replacing Chromebook, whichever is less.
2nd incident - Cost of repair or cost of replacing Chromebook, whichever is less.
3rd incident - Cost of repair or cost of replacing Chromebook, whichever is less.
Student loses take-home privileges until the financial obligations are taken care of and an administrative decision is made regarding the student's possible further use of the equipment.

Additional Information: In cases of theft, vandalism, and other criminal acts, a police report (or fire report in the case of fire) MUST be filed by the student or parent. A copy of the police/fire report must be provided to the principal's office.

Intentional Damage: Students/Parents are responsible for full payment of intentional damages to devices. Warranty or School District device protection DOES NOT cover intentional damage to the device.

Lost or Destroyed Replaceable Parts/Accessories: If a student loses or destroys any of the following components, they will be charged full replacement costs for those items: power module/cord, battery and carrying case.
