3.1 MEASLES OUTBREAK

A Measles outbreak has moved into our region. President Tanya Burton reported that what started out as two cases in the Lubbock area has grown into dozens in a very short period of time. She explained what signs and symptoms to look for in the students. Stressing how important it is to separate any student with a suspected case. The student would need to see their health professional immediately and it must be reported to the state.

A copy of the letter President Burton received from the state was shared with the committee. The letter was printed and mailed to all unvaccinated students today, February 19, 2025. This vaccination is given in two doses, about 1 and 4 years of age. President Burton personally called parents of students that had only received one dose of the vaccine. She strongly encouraged them to have the second dose.
