# Introduction

Hello band, My name is Mr. Jacob Diaz. I am the new director of bands and graduated from West Texas A&M University. My primary instrument is percussion and my secondary instrument is Clarinet. In my free time I like to watch football and write music. My goal this year is to have a successful band.

# **Grading Policies**

Grades will be entered daily. Grades that will be taken for are; chair test, pass-offs, concerts, scales/theory test and homework. **For any reason that you are not here please alert the school or the band director.** Grades will be entered as follows;

- <u>Chair Test(Only for 6th Grade)</u>- Every day the students will do a chair test that will be playing a line from their warm-up books or scales. It will be weighted 10%.
- <u>Pass-offs</u> Pass offs are for students to pass off music that we are playing this year. Students must record themselves playing the music that is required to pass off. It will be weighted **10%**. Pass-Offs include:
  - □ Scales (major, minor)
  - □ Concert Music
  - □ All-Region Music
  - □ Solo Music
- <u>Concerts</u> Concerts are a must attend event by every student. This would allow the student to demonstrate what they are doing in band and how well they progress. It will be weighted 25%. The attire for concerts will be:
  - Black Pants
  - □ Band Polo Shirt
  - □ Black Shoes
  - Black socks
- <u>Test(Only for 6th Grade)</u>- Every Friday the students will be taking a test that covers; music theory, scales, and rhythmic patterns. It will be weighted 25%.
- <u>Test(Only for 7th and 8th Grade)</u> It will be weighted 25%. Test will be there concerts which consist of their:
  - □ Halloween & Christmas Concert
  - Pre-UIL Concert
  - UIL Concert
  - □ Spring Concert

- <u>Participation</u> Every student must participate in any school related band rehearsals in the afternoon, contest and other related band activity. It will be weighted 25%.
- <u>Homework</u> Every day the student will bring their instrument home to practice and must be recorded on their practice logs and must be signed by parents every day. It will be graded as a homework assignment. It will be weighted 15%.

<u>6th Grade Weighted:</u> 15%(HW) + 25%(P) + 25%(Test) + 25%(C) + 10%(Chair Test) <u>7th & 8th Grade:</u> 15%(HW) + 25%(P) + 25%(Test) + 25%(C) + 15%(Pass Off)

- Develop and embouchure / stick grip / hand position

- Develop technical instrumental proficiency (fingering, articulation, rudiments, scales, etc.)
